## St Thomas' CE Primary School Person Specification for Early Years Teacher

## The successful candidate must have the following essential qualities:

- 1. have qualified teacher status (QTS), recognised by the DFE;
- 2. be able to create a stimulating, interesting and effective learning environment which promotes high standards of behaviour and attitudes to learning;
- 3. show commitment and enthusiasm for raising pupils' achievement;
- 4. have a working knowledge of the early years curriculum and its assessment;
- 5. make use of effective planning and record keeping procedures to meet the needs of all children;
- 6. have a clear understanding of inclusion issues and an awareness of how to cater for individual needs; children with SEN and those from diverse ethnic and cultural backgrounds, including those for whom English is an additional language;
- 7. be able to communicate clearly and effectively, both orally and in writing to all members of the wider school community;
- 8. be a team member and be able to delegate to and manage support staff;
- 9. be IT literate.

## It is desirable, but by no means essential, for candidates to have some of the following:

- 1. strengths in and an enthusiasm for teaching in the EYFS;
- 2. skills and interest in the visual arts; media, film, web-design, fine arts, design;
- 3. work experience in an area other than teaching;
- 4. evidence of continued personal professional development;
- 5. an excellent health record.
